## Internet and Computer Use Agreement for Minors

---

It is not possible for Library staff to control specific information people may locate on the Internet. Responsibility for, and any restriction of, a child's use of the Internet rests solely with the child's **parent(s) or legal guardian**.

The Library requires minor children under the age of 18 to have an Internet and Computer Use Agreement on file at the Library in order to use the Library's computer resources.

### Libraries

- Do not vouch for or endorse the viewpoints of written material in their collections as well as *electronic information accessible on the Internet*
- Have in place selection policies that serve to govern the purchase of written materials that *may not apply to material accessed electronically*
- Uphold the right of each individual to have access to constitutionally protected material
- Affirms the right and responsibility of parents and legal guardians to determine and monitor their own children's use of library materials and resources
